An abstinence-based alcohol and other drug residential rehabilitation for cis and trans men.

About Quin House

Quin House is a 12-week, voluntary Supported Accommodation Rehabilitation Service that supports homeless and socially marginalised adult men (cis and trans) with substance dependencies. Our goal is to break the cycle of dependency, homelessness, and social exclusion through:

- Safe accommodation combined with therapeutic interventions
- Relapse prevention planning
- Health & wellbeing stabilisation
- Life skills development
- Relationship building
- Support to access long-term housing

How Quin House Works

We take a holistic approach to recovery, offering a combination of:

- Group sessions & individual counselling
- Life skills training
- Supportive staff role modelling
- Community activities & volunteer work

Each resident collaborates with a case manager to develop an individualized treatment plan. This plan identifies goals and strategies to address key barriers such as:

- Physical & mental health challenges
- Relationship with substance use
- Legal & financial concerns
- Trauma & family breakdown

Residents also participate in volunteer work at local community gardens and engage in therapeutic activities outside of Quin House to support their recovery journey.

A Safe and Inclusive Service

We are committed to providing a safe and inclusive environment, particularly for Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander communities and the LGBTQIA+ community. Quin House benefits from VincentCare's Rainbow Tick Accreditation and ongoing progress toward our Reconciliation Action Plan (RAP). Individuals from these communities are prioritised for service.

Eligibility

To access Quin House, individuals must:

- Identify as male (cis or trans)
- Be 18 years or older
- Be homeless or at risk of homelessness
- Experience substance use challenges and seek abstinence-based recovery
