Short term intensive case management and support for single adults who identify as women, who are living in insecure or inappropriate housing.

About the Women's Early Intervention Program (WEIP)

The Women's Early Intervention Program provides six weeks of short-term intensive case management and support for adults who identify as women, who are at risk of losing their housing, or living in insecure or inappropriate housing.

The program provides outreach support, assertive engagement, advocacy, information and referral.

This is complemented by ongoing assessments, case planning and review; as well as linking those with diverse support needs such as mental health, substance use, legal, family violence and social isolation to appropriate services.

Eligibility

The target group is adults who identify as female and:

- Are single with no dependents
- Residing or staying in the North West region of metropolitan Melbourne; and
- Requiring support to maintain and sustain their tenancy

How to Refer

Clients can self-refer, or a worker can make a referral on their behalf. Regardless, it must be done via one of the following channels:

- VincentCare Northern Community Hub's Initial Assessment and Planning team
- Ozanam House via drop in or utilizing other
 Ozanam House services
